"We worked on five houses during the week. The most extensive project was fixing up a home for a women with emphysema. She could not walk into her dining room for fear of falling through it. Also her front stairs were unsafe. The Foundry VIM team reinforced her floor and laid new plywood. They also replaced the front steps and the drywall in one bedroom."



"I worked on the roof of another home all week. Other projects included building steps and fixing up a shed, putting final touches on a bathroom so that it could be used, and trying to figure out why electrical outlets in a house were not functioning."



"The eleven members of the Foundry VIM team worked all week in hot weather (upper 90's) but did take time on Thursday afternoon to attend the fish fry at the Bayou La Batre United Methodist Church."
