## THE TIE THAT UNBINDS

### Life Together

Our life together in community has at its center the proclamation of “Christ crucified,” a challenging message from the very beginning. How can a person who freely allowed himself to be humiliated and killed be the one we follow as leader and Lord? How can something that seems so foolish be called powerful and wise? What does Jesus’ way of living and dying teach us about how to live? The apostle Paul grapples with these questions and with the divisions and quarreling of the 1st century Corinthian church in his first letter to that community. The first several chapters of 1 Corinthians and other texts that help us explore these central questions of our faith will be our guide as we explore the meaning and power of the cross—for our lives and our life together.
